

## **Application and Admission Process**

Please follow the instructions below to begin the application for the dual-degree BSN program at EMU. See International admission deadlines here:

Step 1: Apply to EMU at this link: <a href="https://app.emich.edu/ug/register">https://app.emich.edu/ug/register</a> Done prior to July 1, 2023 Deadline for International student admissions. You will be prompted to enter an email address, which will become your username, and to establish a password. Your information is transmitted through a secured server. You will receive an email requesting confirmation of your identity. Once your username and password has been confirmed, you may return to this system at any time.

Transfer and Second Bachelor's students: Effective January 22, 2018, all international, post-secondary transcripts from a non-U.S. institution must be submitted directly to one of the following four approved evaluation services for a detailed, course by course report, including copies of the transcripts submitted. Applicants should allow 2–6 weeks for the evaluation to be completed. Choose one of the following options/agencies:

- 2. English language proficiency can be demonstrated for full admission through the minimum test scores found below:
  - (i) SAT Evidence-based Reading and Writing Subscore (EBRW): 48
  - (ii) ACT English Subscore: 19
  - (iii) TOEFL: 61 iBT (TOEFL Home Edition also accepted)
  - (iv) IELTS: 6.0 (IELTS Indicator also accepted)
  - (v) Michigan English Test (MET): 48
  - (vi) Pearson English Language Test (PTE): 44
  - (vii) Duolingo: 95 (Students admitted based on Duolingo English

Test scores will be required to take an English proficiency exam upon arrival and may be placed into English as a Second Language courses, depending on their performance on this exam).

- 3. A financial Statement of Responsibility (will be required when applying for I-20) must be completed to demonstrate the ability to cover all expenses while attending EMU
- 4. Complete required visa processes. Must receive by July 23, 2023
